About the programme

The virtual training “Capacity Building for Insurance Supervisors: Leveraging Actuarial Skills”, is organised by the [Access to Insurance Initiative \(A2ii\)](#), the [International Actuarial Association \(IAA\)](#), and the [International Association of Insurance Supervisors \(IAIS\)](#).

The training is targeted at entry- to middle-level officials involved in the regulation and supervision of insurers. It aims at strengthening the understanding and implementation of the actuarial concepts and tools necessary to support effective insurance supervision and regulation.

The training syllabus is broken down into the following components:

1. Enterprise Risk Management
2. Valuation and Actuarial Reports
3. Reinsurance
4. Risk-based Capital

The training is offered at no cost to insurance supervisors; however, places are limited. We will accept approximately 2 supervisors per jurisdiction until maximum cohort size of around 35 participants is reached.

Programme structure

The programme has **two required components** that you must complete to earn your certificate:

1. [Self-paced learning modules](#) on the Connect.A2ii learning platform. These must be completed before the live sessions. The training is available to any supervisor registered on the platform.
2. Live Sessions with trainers and experts on **Tuesday, 31 October 2023 and on Tuesdays and Thursdays for two weeks in November: 21, 23, 28, and 30 November 2023**

The training will be delivered in English. The modules will be accessible on the Connect.A2ii platform, and the live sessions will take place on MS Teams.

Live Session Dates

The live sessions will take place Tuesdays and Thursdays, from 21 to 30 November 2023, with a mandatory onboarding session on Tuesday, 31 October, from 13:00 – 16:30 CET.

Certificates

We expect that participants attend 100% of the sessions and complete 100% of the self-paced modules on [Connect.A2ii](#) to receive the certificate at the end of the course.

However, if we are notified of any special circumstances, participants will still receive the certificate if they have at least 75% attendance at the live sessions (at least 3 out of the 4 days scheduled).
